To qualify as a Level 2 Official you need to have:

- a) Obtained an officials’ level 1 licence.
- b) Completed your Record of Experience form via your [myathletics portal](#) in detail for at least 10 meetings in your chosen discipline (of which 4 may have already been submitted for level 1). Once completed this needs to be exported and sent with your documents for assessment.
- c) Have one positive report completed by an official in the same discipline who has been Level 3 or above for at least 2 years. **For field judges this must include working on a long throw and showing understanding of the long throws protocol.** Discipline specific report forms can be found [here](#)
- d) Complete the questions on your discipline which you will find [here](#) There is no reason why you should not discuss your answers with other officials, including your mentor. These questions are here to help you to develop as an official and you will need to use your rule book when answering them.
